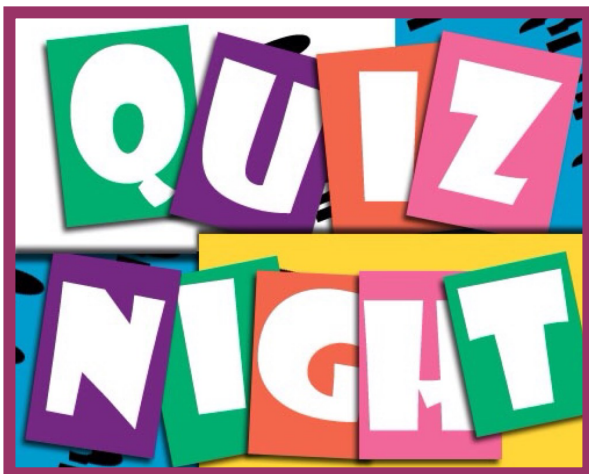

WAR MEMORIAL RESTORATION UPDATE | In the last newsletter it was reported the contractor had been appointed to carry out restoration cleaning of the war memorial.

The first phase restoration works have now been completed, with the colour of the red sandstone cleaning up very well.

The next phase includes a review of the landscaping and adjacent grassed area, with a view to hopefully improving access.

A rededication service will be arranged over the coming months in preparation for Remembrance / Armistice Day, Sunday 11th November 2018. Full details will be advertised once arranged.



BURSTWICK FLOOD WARDENS - VOLUNTEERS NEEDED | Burstwick Flood wardens carried out a successful wet test run of the flood pumps on Friday 8th December 2017. This involved connecting up two large pumps to the hook-up point on the Skeckling Drain and running the pumps for 30 minutes, to check they were operating correctly and to pump water from one side of the drain to the other, to lower the water levels in the drain.



A small group of volunteer wardens look after the pumps and make sure they are ready to be used to help reduce the risk of flooding in parts of the village. The group is supported by the Environment Agency and Burstwick Parish Council.
