CONCERNED ABOUT ROAD SAFETY IN BURSTWICK?

Burstwick welcomes many walkers, cyclists and horse riders along with children going to and from school. Their safety is paramount. The parish council continues to lobby ERYC to improve road safety in the village.

Whilst Burstwick has been listed for further assessment during 2022-23, to determine volume and types of vehicles along with traveling speed, the parish council is calling on concerned residents to email the ERYC Traffic Management team via traffic.management@eastriding.gov.uk. Traffic Management work closely with other agencies such as the Police, Community Speed Watch and Safer Roads Humber in addressing local concerns with perceived speed. Individual incidents, which are of immediate road safety concern, should be reported to the Police on the non-emergency number (101) as this will add to the body of evidence.
